- 11E approx. 18 miles - 502N to Dryden – 17W to Vermilian Bay – 105N to Red Lake – Turn left at stop light – 618/Howey St. approx. 7 miles to Flat Lake Rd/Suffel Lake Rd.(logging road) - Turn right - 12 miles to Black Bear Lodge parking area on the right.

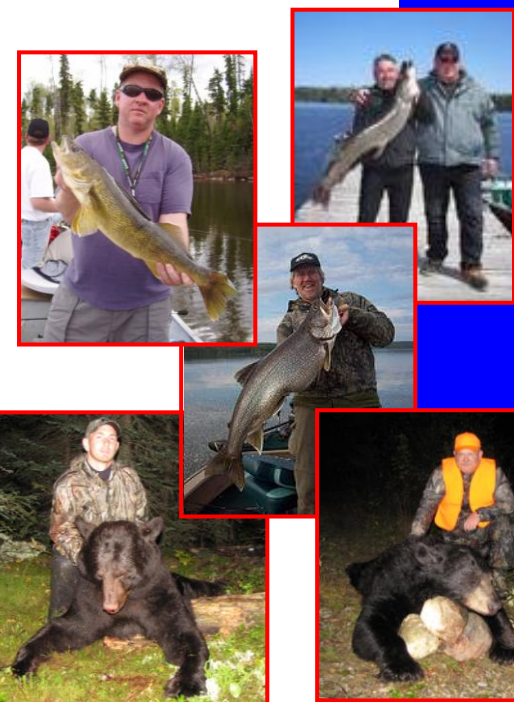
